## Dress Code Clarifications

Please review our dress code policy, which is detailed in your handbook, and help your child cooperate fully. Following are some issues that may need your attention:

Students will wear only Freedom shirts; it is not permissible to wear a long sleeve shirt under a short sleeve Freedom shirt. If
