Remember:

► **Please follow arrival and dismissal procedures as described on the Freedom Facts.** When dropping off students in K5-8th grade, please stay on the west side of the building and let your child out at the sidewalk. Do not pull around to the back of the building! Doing so will interfere with traffic that is coming from the east side of the building and pose danger to our children.

► **Tuition payments for this school year begin on September 1.** Please be reminded that payments are due on the first of

the month and are late on the second of the month! A late fee of \$50 is added to accounts not paid by the fifth of the month. According to school board policy, any student whose account falls more than a month behind will be suspended until payment is made. The board will be enforcing this policy this year, so please keep your account current.
