Infant/Toddler Center Information & Fees

The Infant/Toddler curriculum provides opportunities for children to learn about God's world and how to live in it. Activities which embrace physical, mental, social, emotional and spiritual development are included to help lay a foundation for understanding God, Jesus, the Bible, the church, self, others and the natural world.

FCA offers a full-time program for the following fee:

\$173.00 per week for Infants

\$162.00 per week for Toddler 1

\$157.00 per week for Toddler 1B

\$152.00 per week for Toddler 2

Registration fee: \$100.00 (Non-refundable)

Fees include nutritious hot lunches & two snacks each day.

The Infant/Toddler Center is open Mon.-Fri., 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. The center is open year-round but is closed on major holidays and for inclement weather.

K3 - K4 Tuition

Active members of Chilhowee Hills Baptist Church will pay \$3,732 (**\$311 per month for 12 months**).

Families who are not members of CHBC will pay \$4,944 (**\$412.00 per month for 12 months**).

Note: K3 students must be potty-trained before school starts.

K5 - 8th Grade Tuition

Active members of Chilhowee Hills Baptist Church will pay \$3,240 (**\$270.00 per month for 12 months**).

Families who are not members of CHBC will pay \$4,044 (**\$337.00 per month for 12 months**).

Fees

All K3-8th grade students must pay the following:

Registration Fee: \$100.00 (Non-refundable)

Activity Fee: \$100.00

Book Fee: \$200.00

Note: After-school care, summer care and lunches are not included in tuition. Tuition payments are due the first of each month. We accept cash, check or credit card (VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express).

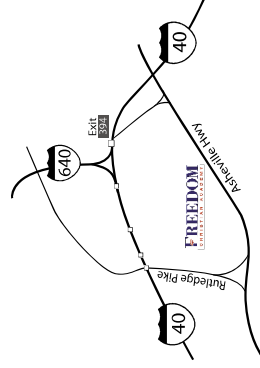

Admission and Enrollment

FCA admits students of any race, color, nationality, or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students in the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, or other school-administered programs.

FCA will only enroll those students whose academic, physical, and emotional needs can be met. FCA has the right to positively affect the school climate by refusing admission to or removing from the school any student or family whose influence would be detrimental to the goals of the school.

Admission Procedure

1. An application must be completed in full and submitted with the non-refundable registration fee.
 2. Families are interviewed by a member of the administrative team to determine admission feasibility and grade placement. An admission test may be administered to determine admission feasibility and/or grade placement.
 3. Students enrolling for the first time must have:
 - Official copy of the birth certificate (not the mother's copy)
 - Complete medical examination form
 - Proof of required immunizations
 - Social security numberAdditional information may be required for K3 & K4.
- Note: On or before Sept. 30th of the entering school year:
- K3 students must be three years old and potty-trained.
 - K4 students must be four years old.
 - Kindergarten students must be five years old.
 - First grade students must be six years old.
